Will Cambodia build a hydropower dam in the Areng Valley?

On February 20, 2017, the Cambodian government said it was indefinitely putting off plans for a hydropower dam in Koh Kong province's Areng valley in favor of expanding the 100 MW Sihanoukville CEL power station by 135 MW.

What is Cambodia's first coal-fired power plant?

The 100 MW power station was commissioned in 2014. It was Cambodia's first coal-fired power plant. Starting when it was first proposed in 2008, the plant faced strong opposition from local residents over its environmental and health effects.

How has Cambodia progressed in the EV sector?

Hundreds gathered at the 1st Global New Energy Vehicle (GNEV) Cooperation and Development Forum in Singapore, where EnergyLab gave keynote remarks highlighting Cambodia's recent progress in the EV sector. Does Cambodia buy electricity from neighboring countries?

In addition to local power generation, Cambodia also buys electricity from neighboring countries, especially during the dry season. In 2022, Cambodia's total installed capacity amounted to 4,495 megawatts (MW), while 1,030 MW of power was imported from Thailand, Vietnam, and Laos.

Why is electricity so expensive in Cambodia?

Electricity prices in Cambodia are among the most expensive in the region due to a shortage of integrated high-voltage transmission systems and the high cost of imported diesel fuel. Power in provincial cities is more expensive and less reliable than the supply in Phnom Penh.
