Is solar PV a good option for Brazil's energy mix?

Brazil's 2050 National Energy Plan (NEP 2050) outlines the importance of solar pv for Brazil's energy mix. Solar power has become a competitive alternative as a renewable source of energy and can help the country meet its commitments to reduce greenhouse gases, the report says.

Does Brazil have solar energy?

Solar energy has great potential in Brazil, with the country having one of the highest levels of insolation in the world at 4.25 to 6.5 sun hours/day. As of 2019, Brazil generated nearly 45% of its energy, or 83% of its electricity, from renewable sources. For example, 60% of Brazil's electricity generation came from renewable hydropower.

How many solar power systems will Brazil have in 2024?

Brazil expects to have 1.2 million solar power generation systems in the year 2024. Solar energy has great potential in Brazil, with the country having one of the highest levels of insolation in the world at 4.25 to 6.5 sun hours/day. How much solar power does Brazil have in 2022?

In 2022, Brazil was the 8th country in the world in terms of installed solar power capacity (24.079 GW). Brazil expects to have 1.2 million solar power generation systems in the year 2024.

What is the biggest solar power project in Brazil?

The plant is developed by Enel. Enel through EGBP has started operating its Lapa solar park, which is the biggest solar power project operation in Brazil at present. The plant is situated in Bom Jesus da Lapa, in the north-eastern state of Bahia. Lapa project is made up of 2 plants: Lapa- with an installed capacity of 78 megawatts.

How does solar energy affect job creation in Brazil?

By lowering the rate of annual increases. Impact on job creation: The Brazilian Solar Photovoltaic Energy Association (ABSOLAR) estimates that for every 1 MW of PV installed, 25 to 30 direct jobs are created in the country (ABSOLAR, 2020). In 2019, the sector generated more than 130,000 jobs, and ABSOLAR forecasts

According to ABSOLAR, this 4th place to Brazil results from the 5.7 gigawatts (GW) added in 2021, which was the solar PV highest historical growth in the country. Analyzing the cumulative installed capacity of solar PV, Brazil advanced one position in the world ranking and assumed the 13th place.

According to the mapping, Brazil's eighth position is the result of around 10 gigawatts (GW) added in the year 2022. As a result, last year alone, the solar sector attracted more than R\$ 45.7 billion in new investments, growth of 64% in relation to the financial values accumulated until the end of 2021 in the country.
