

Brief introduction to the development of solar power generation

When did solar energy become a standard power system?

As NASA pushed further out into the solar system in the 1970s, photovoltaics became the standard power system for its spacecraft and remains so today. Back on Earth, solar energy technology continued to advance gradually through the mid-20th century but remained uncompetitive with cheap, readily available fossil fuels.

When did solar power start?

As the U.S. and Soviet Union raced to launch satellites and spacecraft, solar energy offered an attractive way to generate power far from Earth. In 1958, the U.S. launched Vanguard 1, the first solar-powered satellite. Its radically new power system, made up of six solar panels, enabled it to remain in orbit for over six years.

How TE devices can be integrated into solar power generation systems?

TE devices can be integrated into solar power generation systems to collect heat from (1) the cooling system of PV solar panels simply by combining TE modules to collect waste heat from the coolant; or (2) using a sun beam splitter to absorb heat from solar radiation apart from the PV system.

How can solar energy be used to generate electricity?

Sun is an inexhaustible source of energy capable of fulfilling all the energy needs of humankind. The energy from the sun can be converted into electricity or used directly. Electricity can be generated from solar energy either directly using photovoltaic (PV) cells or indirectly using concentrated solar power (CSP) technology.

What is the future of solar energy?

Progress has been made to raise the efficiency of the PV solar cells that can now reach up to approximately 34.1% in multi-junction PV cells. Electricity generation from concentrated solar technologies has a promising future as well, especially the CSP, because of its high capacity, efficiency, and energy storage capability.
