Can You charge a remote with a solar panel?

Note: Remotes with a solar panel will have a large silver panel on the back. If your remote does not have this, but has the USB-C port, it can be charged with a USB-C cable only. If the remote's battery ever completely depletes and you need it charged right away, you can use a USB-C charging cable.

Can I use my solarcell remote without a Samsung account?
