

Can Egypt turn SCZONE into a green energy hub?

Specifically, Egypt is investing strenuous efforts to turn SCZONE into a clean energy production and green fuels hub. Egypt has abundant wind and solar resources which can be used to produce green hydrogen and hydrogen-based green fuels such as e-methanol and ammonia.

Can Egypt become a regional energy trading hub?

Egypt's robust oil and gas infrastructure aligns with its ambition to establish itself as a regional energy trading hub. The country's strategic location and substantial resources position it as a promising candidate for this role.

Will Egypt be a green hydrogen hub?

Egypt has recently adopted a vision to be a global and regional hub for green hydrogen production, storage and export, signing in late August seven Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) to establish industrial complexes to produce green hydrogen in the Ain Al-Sokhna Industrial Zone, which is located within the Suez Canal Economic Zone (SCZONE).

Is Egypt a regional energy hub?

Egypt as a Regional Energy Hub In the past two years, after the Russian military operation in Ukraine, Egypt's position as a natural gas trading hub was intensified as the country's LNG exports to Europe increased. Egypt's exports of LNG grew by 14% year-on-year to 7.5 million tons in 2022, as reported by El Ahram Newspaper.

What is Egypt doing with the Maersk Group?

Egypt's President Abdel-Fattah El-Sisi directed on Monday the start of cooperation with the global Maersk Group to establish an integrated national network in Egypt to produce and distribute green energy and clean fuels for ships based on new and renewable energy sources.

Egypt is strategically positioning itself as a regional energy hub by focusing on various initiatives in the energy sector, including liquefied natural gas (LNG) exports, Suez Canal expansion, and investments in renewable energy.

Detention is the charge applicable, after the free time expires, for the use of the carrier's full container inside the marine terminal, railroad facilities or container yard. This charge can also apply while the container is undergoing Egypt customs inspections, or while the cargo inside the container is being reworked for safety reasons.

New container stations have been introduced in the seaports of Alexandria, Safaga, and Damietta. Their cost is LE7 billion, LE2.6 billion, and LE5.5 billion, respectively. The station in Alexandria has quays extending on 2.5 kilometers and having a depth of 14.5 meters with an annual capacity of goods circulation of 15 million tons.
