Can you add integrated solar panels to a pre-existing roof?

You can add integrated solar panels to a pre-existing roof- but it comes with some difficulties you won't encounter when installing them on a new build. It'll usually cost more and take longer because the installer will need to remove the roof's tiles or slates, and generally because of the greater complexity level.

Why are integrated solar panels better than on-roof solar panels?

This is because, unlike on-roof solar panels, integrated panels sit snugly in the roof rather than mounted on brackets. This means that there's less air ventilation around the panel to help keep it cool. On very hot days, this lack of ventilation can lead your panels to overheat and generate less energy. What does this mean for homeowners?

Are solar panels too heavy for a roof?

Standard solar panels can be too heavy for some roofs, which can cause maintenance issues with both the building and the panels. However, since roof-integrated systems aren't placed on top of tiles, but replace them, they'll add little additional weight - if any - to your roof.

Should solar panels be added to a cut roof?

Any proposed loading increase in both historic and more recent cut roofs should therefore be investigated by a structural engineer. The addition of solar panels should not affect the positive wind pressure acting on roofs, as they are aligned to the profile of the roof.
