

Most powerful solar panel Poland

At the close of December 2023, Poland's cumulative installed solar PV capacity had reached 17,057MW, the largest among all renewable sources. This was followed by wind (9,428MW) and hydro (979MW). Last year, Poland's new solar additions reached 4.6GW, as calculated by the IEO based on a study published in May 2023.

Poland is on track to connect more than 6 GW of new solar photovoltaic (PV) systems to the grid in 2023, bringing the cumulative solar capacity in the country to over 18 GW, according to estimates by the Institute for Renewable Energy IEO.

Despite the challenges mentioned above, Poland remains one of the fastest-growing solar markets in Europe and ranks third in the top 10 solar PV market additions list for 2023-2026. Prosumers in Poland have still the highest share in the photovoltaic market, and in 2022 they represented 68% of the annual growth of power installed in photovoltaics. The net-billing system results in a higher self-consumption index, since PV installations are more optimally sized due to the settlement method of surplus electrical power produced.
