



Norfolk Island raid battery backup unit

It has cache of 256MB or 512MB and a BBU (battery backup Unit) and directly supports 8 disks via 2 x 4 port cables PERC6i/R is an entry level "RAID Controller" that supports RAID0 and 1. It has no BBU capability and supports 8 disks via 2 x 4 port cables. So if you are getting PERC6/iR's, battery backup doesn't enter the picture :whiste:

Step 3 Insert the battery pack harness connector at the end of the colored wires into the J4 connector on the rear side of the iBBU07. Step 4 Connect one end of the 20-pin, 10-inch cable to the J2 connector on the iBBU07 and the other end to the J10 battery backup connector of the SAS 8880EM2 RAID controller, as shown in Figure 3.

Modern RAID controllers have integrated caches for increasing performance. With corresponding protective mechanisms, the content of these caches would be lost when a power failure occurs. For that reason, the cache content is often protected by a BBU or BBM (depending on the manufacturer, either the term Battery Backup Unit (BBU) or Battery Backup Module (BBM) is ...
