How much does solar energy cost in Kenya?

Levelized Cost of Energy (LCOE) and simple payback period of US\$ 0.143/kWh and 9.1 years respectively. Kenya boasts of abundant solar irradiation potential across its expansive regions, averaging between 4.5 kWh/m and 6 kWh/m per day. Despite this advantageous condition, solar energy's contribution to the national energy mix remains relatively low.

How does solar energy work in Kenya?

Solar energy can be extracted at an efficiency rate of approximately 10-17 %,which can then be converted into heat (thermal) or through solar photovoltaic systems to generate electricity. The global horizontal irradiation (GHI) in Kenya is approximately 2400 kWh/m² /year,indicating substantial potential .

What are the main aspects of solar electrification in Kenya?
