

Just shy of fifteen thousand solar panels, the St. Lucia Electricity Services Limited (LUCELEC) 3MW Solar Farm in La Tourney, Vieux Fort is now feeding solar energy into the island's electricity grid. This is the island's first utility-scale solar farm. As of April 11, the entire 3 MW was online, producing its maximum output.

The \$20 million project, located north of Hewanorra International Airport, is historic for Saint Lucia. It is the first utility-scale renewable energy project on the island and is funded, owned and operated by LUCELEC. Its nearly 15,000 panels will generate approximately 7 million kWhs (or units) of electricity per year.

The State University of Campinas (Unicamp) has launched the CampusGrid microgrid on its Barão Geraldo campus, the largest university microgrid in Latin America and the Caribbean. LUCELEC and the Government of St. Lucia aim to supplement the diesel generators with renewable energy systems including PV in order to reduce the negative effects of burning fossil fuels, stabilize electricity rates, and reduce energy production costs.

# Saint Lucia solar bess system

German utility RWE has announced its investment decision to construct Australia's inaugural eight-hour battery energy storage system (BESS) in New South Wales. The project, adjacent to an existing solar farm near Balranald, will feature a capacity exceeding 50MW and 400 megawatt hours.

A 600 kW, 760 kWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) has been integrated with The University of Queensland (UQ) Gatton Solar Research Facility (GSRF).
