Georgia does not have any statewide incentive programs but there are programs through local communities or utility companies that can help homeowners finance solar. These include the Central Georgia EMC Home Plus Loan Program and the Georgia Power Home Energy Improvement Program.

South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands are only accessible by sea. There is no visitor accommodation ashore, therefore most people visit by cruise ship or yacht. All visits require a visit permit. Visit permit applications for both commercial and private vessels are submitted by the vessel owners or operators.

Perched like small dots in the middle of the South Atlantic Ocean between South America, Africa, and the continent of Antarctica, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands have limited territory and a tiny population. South Georgia is only 100 miles long and 20 miles wide, with snow perpetually covering most of the island.

There are limited options which visit the Falkland Islands and South Georgia only. These are typically offered by Lindblad Expeditions. Yet Seabourn, Scenic, Swan Hellenic, and others visit South Georgia once or twice a year. There are also expeditions which do Cape to Cape crossing and visit islands in the South Atlantic Ocean. These are often the most ...

The island of South Georgia is unusual among oceanic islands for having pre-Cretaceous sedimentary rocks underlying much of the island and a significant portion of felsic igneous rocks. Two-thirds of the island consists of intensely folded flysch, capped with Aptian age fossils, tuff and greywacke in the Cumberland Bay Series.
