What happens if a solar PV company goes out of business?

Sometimes solar PV companies sell on installations, or the ownership changesif a company goes out of business. If you're unsure who owns the solar panels on your home, you can contact energy regulator Ofgem's Feed-In Tariff Register Team at fitregister@ofgem.gov.uk.

What if I signed up for free solar panels?

If you signed up for free solar panels when the FIT rate was at its highest, back in 2011, we calculated that you could miss out on as much as £23,000 for a 4kWp system. You would also have saved more than £5,000 over 25 years from the electricity produced by the panels.

Can a person own a solar PV installation?

While an individual can own the solar PV panels installed at their property, there are instances where the owner of an installation may be different from the owner of the property or site at which the installation is located.

Are solar PV installations sold between companies?

However,we are aware that in some instances solar PV installations are sold between companies, especially when companies go out of business. This change in ownership may not be communicated to the homeowner.

Do you need a lease agreement for solar panels?

If you're moving into a property with solar panels installed as part of a 'rent-a-roof' scheme, there should be a signed agreement between the homeowner and the rent-a-roof company. This could be a lease agreement, where the homeowner agrees to rent out their roof space to the company which installed the solar panels.

If you have installed solar panels or another renewable system since the FIT closed, you should be able to sign up with a supplier offering SEG payments as long as you meet the criteria. You won't be able to claim back ...
